We're eliminating as much garbage on-site as possible, and we need your help. All coordinators, vendors, volunteers and participants are being asked to make every effort possible to reduce potential garbage by only bringing items on-site that can be composted or recycled.

Zero Waste is the direction we're heading, and it's not that far off. With the help of the CVRD we've taken recycling to a whole new level and most people are surprised at what they can compost or recycle through the program we're initiating.

Commercial composting technology means we can accept almost anything organic. We have a one-stop-drop recycling systems on-site for almost any clean paper, plastic or metal item. Together we can avoid almost all potential garbage. On site this year will be a series of strategically located *"Recycling Centers"* with four receptacles each. Please scan through the four options described below then use the appropriate receptacle when you are at the event.

Your help in our goal to be more green is much appreciated.

1. ORGANICS PLUS

- Any Food** - cooked or raw, grease, bones, meat, fish, poultry, etc.
- Waxed Paper & Food Containers** - cups, milk cartons, burger wrapping, etc.
- Waxed Cardboard** - food supply boxes
- Soiled Paper** - pizza boxes, hand towels, napkins, plates, trays, etc.

2. REFUNDABLES

- Drink Boxes**
- Glass Bottles**
- Aluminium Cans**
- Plastic Bottles**

3. RECYCLABLES

- Clean Plastics** - bags, wrapping, containers
- Clean Paper** - unwaxed cardboard, boxes, paper, etc.
- Clean Metal** - tin cans, lids, foil, etc.

4. GARBAGE

- Soiled Plastics** - drink lids, straws, wrapping, cutlery
- Styrofoam / Polystyrene**
- Miscellaneous Items**
